Looking for a city rich in culture and history? “Look No More.” The historic **Route 66** – the Mother Road - runs through **Claremore** and should be your first stop to the Spirit of the West.

The small town atmosphere opens its arms to all who come- families and tourists alike. Whether it’s for a day or weekend, visitors should allow plenty of time to explore what the Claremore area has to offer- from lodging in the city or that quaint bed and breakfast, state museums, antique shops, collectibles - to touring the historical and stately **Belvidere Mansion**.

The **J.M. Davis Arms & Historical Museum** is considered to be the world’s largest collection with more than 20,000 guns and related items. The collection also includes saddles, knives and Native American artifacts, and over 600 WWI posters.

The **Will Rogers Museum** and **Will Rogers birthplace** (Oologah) is a tribute to the enduring popularity of the humorist, actor, and newspaper columnist. Theaters, interactive video, art, artifacts, memorabilia, saddles, photographs and manuscripts depict the life of the man who was loved worldwide.
